In order to achieve safety at sea, prevention of human injury or loss of life, protection of the environment and in particular, but not limited to, the marine environment, and the avoidance of damage to property, the Company considers of paramount importance the safe operation of all ships under its management. Safety policies comply with relevant national and international laws, rules and regulations.

Company's objectives are to:

- Provide for safe practices in ship operation and a safe working environment.
- Assess all identified risks to our ships, personnel and environment and establish appropriate safeguards
- Continuously improve the safety management skills of personnel ashore and aboard ship, including preparing for emergencies related both to safety and environmental protection.

In order to achieve the objectives of the Policy, the Company shall:

- Maintain high standards of safety consciousness and strict personnel (both ashore and on board) discipline and accountability,
- Ensure compliance with the documented Safety Management System and compliance with Rules and Regulations through periodical (internal) inspections and audits,
- Ensure personnel readiness for emergency situations (safety and environmental protection),
- Review and monitoring of the Safety Management System by senior management,
- Actively encourage and support personnel participation in the implementation of the Policy,
- Maintain a healthy working environment.
